ST. MARK PARISH NEEDS

We are blessed that God is presenting us with an exciting opportunity as a Parish to create a new “campus” to serve our thriving family of St. Mark Parishioners. Following the completion of a thorough pre-campaign study, along with detailed planning and parish-wide meetings, we believe St. Mark is completely prepared to pursue this project.

St. Mark serves almost 1100 families and supports many ministries. Our current physical space hinders our potential. As the first phase of this long-term project, we plan to build a Perpetual Adoration Chapel and renovate the façade of our current church. God willing, we will then build a beautiful new Church and renovate the current church into an event center, all of which will create the space needed to assist our families to enliven their faith and bring others to share in that joy.

“A Beacon of Truth and Beauty” has been chosen as the theme of this campaign. During his tenure as pastor, Fr. Bierbaum has endeavored to align all we do at St. Mark with the “Three Transcendentals” of Truth, Beauty, and Goodness. This has been most apparent in our public worship, where we seek to fulfill the authentic call of Vatican II through reverent, beautiful liturgies. God has now placed before us an opportunity to bring our physical surroundings into harmony with this same vision. Once completed, our new Perpetual Adoration Chapel, our beautiful new Church, and eventually, a school and other elements of this long-term plan, will truly be a beacon of truth and beauty for Highlands Ranch and beyond.

As stewards of our dynamic, growing parish, now is the time to embark on this much-needed project to ensure an environment that will strengthen us in Christ now and for generations to come.

PHASE I - \$35 MILLION

PERPETUAL ADORATION CHAPEL

Will be attached to the south of the current church. When the new Church is built, it will also be connected. There will be a lower level under the Adoration Chapel to flow from the lower level in the current church and to the lower level of the new Church. The Perpetual Adoration Chapel will hold about 40 people.

RENOVATION OF FAÇADE OF CURRENT CHURCH

This renovation will begin to reflect the sacred architecture of the rest of the eventual campus. After these first two steps of Phase I, and the new Church is built, the current church building will be renovated and repurposed as an event center. This space will accommodate large wedding receptions, concerts, lectures, movies, conferences, retreats, and other social activities for the parish, some of which may become a source of revenue.

NEW CHURCH

Designed to last for centuries, not decades, a new cruciform church will be built to the south of the current Church building. The new Church seats approximately 850— 200 more than the current building. The cruciform plan creates discreet spaces for devotional prayer and Sacraments, including a dedicated baptistery in the north transept and transept shrines. The lower level, under the new Church, will include the future home of our parish offices and additional meeting space. A dome and bell tower will serve as visible landmarks for the Church in Highlands Ranch.
